

## Stash Wrap/Scarf

A wonderful use for all of your leftover yarn, DK - Chunky. You can even hold a double strand of fingering or sock.

You will work one row with each color in Linen Stitch.  
Each row starts and ends with 5" of fringe.



We are casting on the length of the wrap/scarf.

Decide how long you want wrap/scarf to be:

\_\_\_" x 5 sts/in = \_\_\_ sts.

(even #)

Wrap shown is 72" long and  
16" wide.

Scarf should be 60" - 70"  
long and 7" wide.

Needles - Size 8, 40" long

Cast on \_\_\_\_\_ sts loosely.



Row 1: (RS) Leaving a 5" tail for fringe, \*K1, slip 1; to end of row. Cut yarn, leaving a 5" tail for fringe.

Row 2: (RS) Leaving a 5" tail for fringe, \*Slip 1, k1; to end of row. Cut yarn, leaving a 5" tail for fringe.

Place a marker on the right side of work at beginning of row. You will always work with RS facing you.

Repeat these 2 rows to desired width. Bind off.

Knot 4 pieces of fringe together. Trim even. Block.
