

Brioche Scarf - Two Color

Yarn: Any weight yarn - 2 colors MC and CC
Needles: 1 or 2 sizes smaller than suggested needle size
16" or 24" circular

Shown: Encore Mega, size 13, 24" needle, 14 sts., 7 1/2" wide.

Abbreviations

YO - yarn over

YF - yarn forward from back to front

Sl - slip stitch as if to purl

wyif - with yarn in front

BRK - Brioche knit: knit the stitch together with the yarn over

BRP - Brioche purl: purl the stitch together with the yarn over



Cast on an even # of stitches with MC for width scarf you prefer. (The brioche stitch will spread)

Set up row 1: With the MC, *P1, slip 1, YO* repeat to end. Do not worry if your YO at the end slips off the needle at this point.

Set up row 2: Slide the stitches to the other end of the needle. With CC, *wyif, slip 1, BRK* repeat to end, at the end, make sure to include the MC YO in the final BRK.

The set up rows are done. You will now work only the following 4 rows. Each side is worked twice, one time with each color. You will work the MC across, then slide the sts back to the other end of the needle and work the CC across to complete the row. At the end of the 2nd pass, you will turn your work like you normally would. I would place a removable marker on the RS of scarf to help keep track of your rows. I used a safety pin.

WS

Row 1: MC - wyif, (**slip 1, YO, BRP**) to the end. Slide sts back.

Row 2: CC - (**BRK, YF, slip 1**) to the end. Turn.

RS

Row 3: MC - (**BRK, YF, slip 1**) to the end. Slide sts back.

Row 4: CC - wyif, (**slip 1, YO, BRP**) to the end. Turn.

Continue with Rows 1 - 4 until you have knit the length you need. Bind off as follows:

End with Row 2.

With MC, (BRK, p1) across row. Turn, bind off loosely in knit. Weave in ends. Enjoy!
